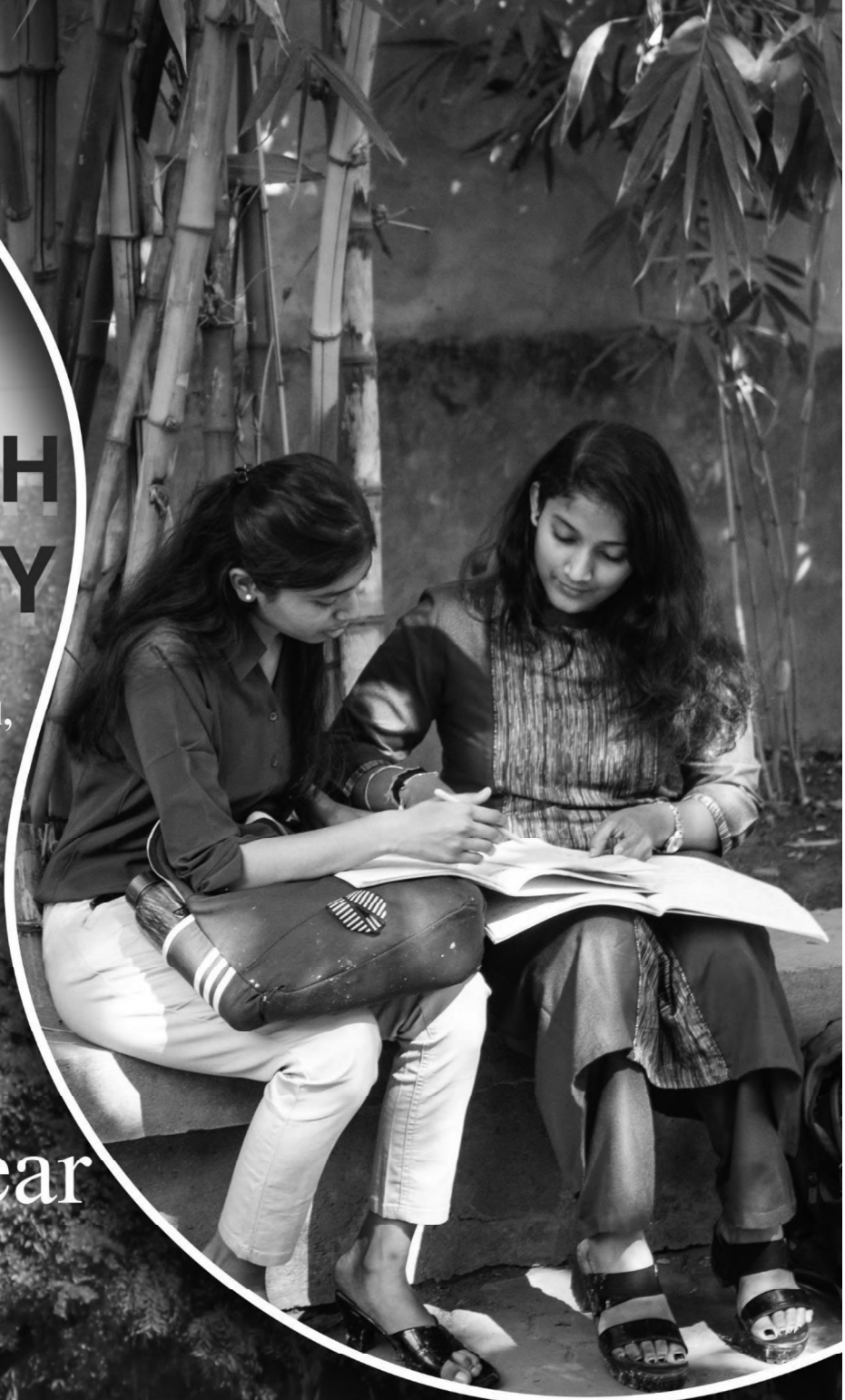

The Annual Report 2023-24 of Shreyarth University serves as a comprehensive record of the institution's academic progress, infrastructural developments, research initiatives, student achievements and administrative roles. This document reflects our commitment to excellence in education and our continuous efforts to align with global standards. It provides valuable insights into the advancements and milestones achieved over the past year, emphasizing our dedication to fostering knowledge, innovation, and holistic development.

In the academic year 2023-24, the university introduced several new programs under the National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020) framework, ensuring a more flexible and research-driven education system. Additionally, the integrated programmes are also covered under the NEP framework in 2023-24. In total, the University has offered 10 programmes in 2023-24. These programs aim to provide students with enhanced learning opportunities, better career prospects, and a strong academic foundation.

The university has witnessed remarkable growth in student enrolments. In the year 2021-22, the University has enrolled 144 students and currently it has enrolled 662 students in 2023-24 across various programmes. Along with this, the University appointed 47 teaching staff with 8 non-teaching staff across various programmes to support the remarkable achievements in the academics of the University. To accommodate the above strength, the University has 19 classrooms equipped with smart board panels and projectors with internet connectivity along with 12 laboratories for various programmes with 271 computers in total. Reading and information objective has been achieved with the 1335 number of books available in the University library for the said year. The University has developed an in-house printing facility for the exam section.

Various faculty members and staff of the University have enrolled Ph. D. programmes, presented papers at the national and international conferences and attended various STTPs, FDPs, workshops, seminars for knowledge enhancement and better serving capabilities to the students by showering the knowledge of current era.

The University follows continuous evaluation pattern for the assessment of the students which is the main criteria behind the implementation of National Education Policy-2020. The students are also assessed through final evaluations under semester end examinations. Under the roof of knowledgeable faculties, students have achieved excellence in the final examinations and major programmes have consistently scored more than 75% of passing the students and approximately more than 90% students have been promoted to the higher semesters with ATKT (allowed to keep term). University and its constituent schools / college have organized 23 curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities to promote students' overall development and to enhance their experiential learning.

Looking ahead, Shreyarth University aims to expand research initiatives, introduce industry-integrated learning programmes, and further strengthen faculty-student engagement. Plans are underway to launch media – digital communication programmes, new short-term certification courses and establish collaborations with leading industries to enhance career prospects for students.

We extend our sincere gratitude to the authorities and advisors, all faculty members, students, administrative staff, and stakeholders for their unwavering support. This report stands as a testimony to the collective efforts made toward academic excellence, and we look forward to another year of success and innovation.

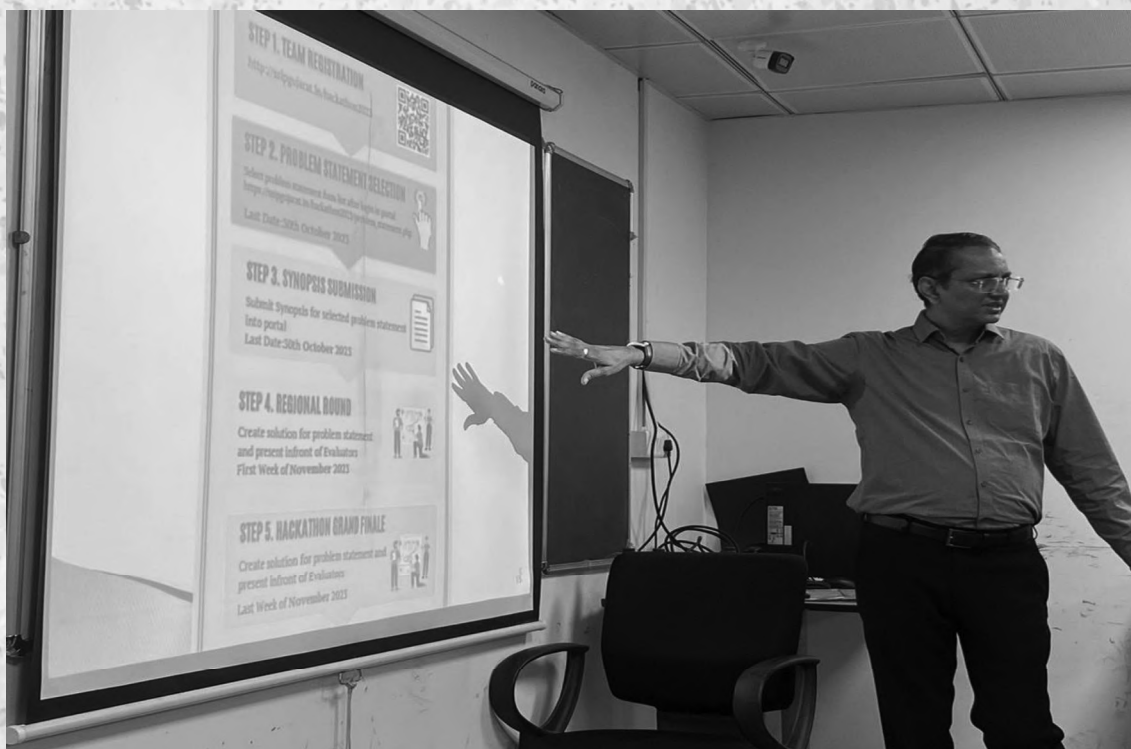
